### **Important Information for Membership Applicants**

#### Passes are not transferable and there are NO REFUNDS!

\*All memberships will expire on 12/31 of the year of purchase.

Add-on Spouse/Child (6-25 yrs only) member policy. Add-on members must live in the same household and be claimed on the initial member's taxes (any add-on members over the age of 18 will be asked to show proof of residency). Child add-on is valid from ages 6-25 (again, they must live in the same house). \*Juniors/Children 17 years of age and under may golf anytime M-F, and Sat & Sun after 2pm.

Tee times are still required of members. Tee times are distributed on a first come, first serve basis. Tee times can be made up to two weeks in advance.

Pierce Lake Golf Course permits daily drop-in and member use. Daily patrons and membership holders have equal use of the building, the course, and events.

Pierce Lake Golf Course reserves the right to book outings, events, and leagues. These events may limit tee time availability. Memberships are not allowed access to outings or events without additional payment or registration. Full Paid Members are allowed ONE league participation, but must first be approved by league organizer and Pierce Lake Golf Course (add-on members do not get this option).

It is recommended that you call ahead to book a tee time or book on-line at www.piercelakegolf.com. Drop-in is allowed if availability allows it.

No minor under the age of 13 may enter the facility without their parent or guardian. Parents or guardians are responsible for the conduct and safety of their children at all times.

Pairing golfers—If three or less people make a tee time, they may be paired with another golfer(s) to make four players.

No outside Alcohol. State Law prohibits alcohol to be brought to the course. All alcohol must be purchased through the golf course.

No golf group larger than four people will be allowed to tee off and play the same hole together. Golfers must hold a valid driver's license (no restrictions) to drive golf carts.

Pace of play = Golfers should be playing the front nine in about 2 hours and 10 minutes, and the back nine in about 2 hours and 20 minutes.

#### Age definitions:

Regular = 26-59 years of age, Student = 18-25 years of age, Senior = 60+ years of age,

Junior = 6-17 years of age (\*Juniors 17 yrs of age and under may golf anytime M-F, and Sat & Sun after 2pm)
